Scripture Reading

- Ezek. 1:5-8 "And from the midst of it there came the likeness of four living creatures. And this was their appearance: They had the likeness of a man. And everyone had four faces, and every one of them had four wings. And their feet were straight feet, and the sole of their feet was like the sole of a calf's foot; and they sparkled like the sight of burnished bronze. And the hands of a man were under their wings on their four sides. And the four of them had their faces and their wings thus:"
- Isa. 40:31 "Yet those who wait on Jehovah will renew their strength; they will mount up with wings like eagles; they will run and will not become weary; they will walk and will not faint."
